


# Reflection from Sr. Helen Flemington

## 4th Sunday Ordinary Time 2017

Blessed are the poor in spirit....the poor in spirit are those who know deeply within themselves that apart from God they are nothing. Their dependence on God is radical and comprehensive. Without God they can do nothing and are nothing. The poor in spirit are empty of all pride and pretensions. They are not satisfied in any way. Any gifts they may possess are just that – gifts given by God. They want nothing but to be filled with the love of God. Everything else takes second place.

Someone reflecting on the beatitudes of Jesus said, "Blessed are those who know they don't have it all put together. Blessed are those who are not certain and yet keep questing. Blessed are those who are uncertain of themselves yet seek certainty. Blessed are those who know that they have missed the mark and yet keep trying to find a better way."

Let us continue to hunger and thirst – for justice, for righteousness, for peace. Our hungers and thirst will allow God into our lives. When we come to acknowledge that we are all empty cups, we will then be in that blessed place where God can fill us.

# Health Corner: Physical Fitness



Physical fitness is important in preventing heart disease and stroke which are the #1 and #5 Killers. The American heart Association recommends 150 minutes of moderate exercise or 75 minutes of vigorous ex-

ercise per week as a minimum. Doing 30 minutes a day for 5 days a week equals 150 minutes. Here are some tips for starting to exercise: 1) gradually increase your training, 2) listen to your body, 3) stay hydrated and wear appropriate clothing, 4) pay attention to lightheadedness, dizziness, chest pains, heart racing or skipping, leg or face swelling and shortness of breath. It is also good to know the location of an AED (automated external defibrillator) or medical assistance. If you do faint while exercising, you should stop and call your physician immediately and don't attempt to return to exercise until you have a physician's consent.

## TAX PREPARATION SEASON IS HERE!

Once again, AIM-VITA, Next\$tepKC, the United Way and the IRS are sponsoring a Free Tax Preparation program for Low Income Wage Earners and Retirees. If your combined family income is less than \$54,000 for 2016 you qualify to have your taxes prepared and electronically filed free of charge. There are many sites throughout the area where you can do this beginning February 1, 2017. One of those sites is right here at St. Therese Little Flower beginning Wednesday, February 8th. An insert in this week's Parish Bulletin explains what you need to know to either schedule a tax preparation appointment here at St. Therese, or, if you wish, to visit another site to have your taxes prepared. We will prepare taxes this year at St. Therese beginning February 8th. You may schedule an appointment by calling the Parish Office at 816-444-4506. 
