

Reflection from Sr. Helen Flemington

5th Sunday Easter 2017

Listen to this experience reported by a man who was learning to fly an airplane. "Some years ago when I was learning to fly, my instructor told me to put the plane into a steep and extended dive. I was totally unprepared for what was about to happen. After a brief time the engine stalled, and the plane began to plunge out-of-control. It soon became evident that the instructor was not going to help me at all. After a few seconds, which seemed like eternity, my mind began to function again. I quickly corrected the situation.

Immediately I turned to the instructor and began to vent my fearful frustrations on him. He very calmly said to me, "There is no position you can get this airplane into that I cannot get you out of. If you want to learn to fly, go up there and do it again." At that moment God seemed to be saying to me, "Remember this. As you serve me, there is no situation you can get yourself into that I cannot get you out of. If you trust me, you will be all right."

This seems to be the situation that Jesus found himself in as he was trying to reassure his friends that everything would turn out for the best. It seems that the most urgent reason he could offer to them was the fact that he had loved them all along, orphaned at this most important time in his life — as he was getting ready to leave them. And so he pleads with them for their trust.

There are many times in our lives when we feel like the man who was learning to fly. Everything seems upside down. We seem to have lost control of everything and the first reaction is panic. We don't know what to do or whom to we can turn. Jesus is asking us for our trust and promising us that he will not let us lose our way.

Health Corner: Bipolar Disorder



Since May is National Mental Health Awareness Month, we are covering some mental health issues in the Health Corners.

Approximately 2.6% or 6 million American Adults live with Bipolar Disorder. This is a

lifelong condition that can affect how you feel and how you act. In the past it was known as manicdepression. It is characterized by dramatic mood swings from overly "high" and/or irritable to sad and hopeless, and back again. The periods of highs and lows are episodes of mania and depression. It is different from the normal ups and downs that everyone goes through. Many people with bipolar disorder seek treatment for the depressive symptoms rather than the manic symptoms so for that reason it may be misdiagnosed. More than 2/3 of people with bipolar disorder were originally misdiagnosed with other disorders. The good news is that most people with bipolar disorder can become mentally balanced through stabilizations of their moods swings and symptoms. Most treatments combine medication and psychosocial treatment but it does require time and patience.


