

Your immune system helps you to fight off diseases, such as colds and flu, but also many more serious diseases. You can do this by:

- Immunizations for children at the regular times required as well as flu, tdap and pneumococcal vaccines for adults.
- Adequate rest helps to reduce the levels of stress hormones in your body. Stress hormones decrease the
 effectiveness of the immune system in fighting viral
 infections (colds and flu).
- Adequate nutrition with the correct amounts of protein and carbohydrates plus fruits and vegetables high in vitamin C help.
- The use of tobacco actually poisons the immune system. Drinking alcohol decreases the effectiveness of the immune system.
- Water is very important to body processes.

The immune system uses some of these processes to fight infection.


